Mid North benefits from major investment in our roads

Geoff is pleased to see roads in the Mid North will benefit from an extra \$110 Million for road maintenance and road safety in the 2015-2016 State Budget.

The Farrell Flat Road and R M Williams Way are among the first projects on which work would begin in the region.

The Work involved is:

- 16 kilometres of Farrell Flat Road between Clare and Farrell Flat
- 6 kilometres of the RM Williams Way between Clare and Spalding

These works will complement other works underway in the region including the reconstructing of the Bute to Kulpara Road and the upgrading of the Laura to Gladstone Road.

Work includes rehabilitation and resealing, shoulder sealing and installation of audio tactile line marking. The road infrastructure stimulus package will boost productivity and improve safety on regional roads.

Geoff urges all drivers utilising this road to take care and adhere to speed restrictions in place during these road works. Geoff looks forward to the improvement in road safety this funding will provide.
