Fund My Idea Barossa and Lower Light entries closing soon

Regional Development Minister Geoff Brock says there's still time for project ideas to be submitted for the Barossa, Light and Lower North 'Fund My Idea' program.

"Anyone can submit an idea to support the Barossa, Light, Mallala and Gawler council areas," Mr Brock said.

"The unique nature of the 'Fund My Idea' program means that the general public suggests and votes on project ideas making the outcome truly community-focused.

"This gives regional South Australians an opportunity to turn their great ideas into reality and have their say in where funds are directed.

"Voting will open on Friday 20 November and I encourage people in the Barossa, Light and Lower North to visit the YourSay website and vote for their favourite idea.

"This program is a real opportunity for local communities to make decisions about the things that matter to them," Mr Brock said.

\$150,000 a year is available through the Regional Development Fund's Country Cabinet 'Fund My Idea' program, which provides \$50,000 to each region that hosts a Country Cabinet meeting.

Project proposals can be submitted via the YourSay website allowing the public to vote on their favourite idea.

Idea submissions close at 5pm on Monday 16 November. Voting will be open from Friday 20 November to Monday 7 December.
