### **NEWS RELEASE – GROWING OUR REGIONAL COMMUNITIES**

Independent Member for Frome Geoff Brock is calling for a fair share of projected revenue flowing from a potential nuclear waste storage facility to be set aside for SA's regional communities.

Mr Brock has written to Premier Jay Weatherill outlining his proposal ahead of tomorrow's public release of the SA Nuclear Fuel Cycle Royal Commission's findings on the management, storage and disposal of nuclear radioactive waste.

The Royal Commission has indicated in its tentative findings that the facility has the potential to generate \$5 billion a year in revenue for the State over the first 30 years of operation and \$2 billion a year beyond that.

Our regions are the lifeblood of this State.

If a storage facility is to be located in regional South Australia, the regions must have a fair share of the potential revenue windfall.

For example, a fair share of not less than 10% of the projected \$5 billion a year would potentially see \$500 million flowing into our regions annually.

That would be a real game changer for our regional communities.
