State Government's \$3.2m investment to country roads

The South Australia Government is investing more than \$3.2 million to improve safety on country roads.

Almost 50 kilometres of roads in the Mid North and Barossa will be upgraded.

The Frome Electorate welcomes the following road works:

- Pt Wakefield – Auburn Road – 1km west of Auburn
- Blyth Township, Harley Street to South Terrace
- Black Rock – Clare Road – 1km south of Spalding
- Laura Gladstone Road – Gladstone North
- Black Rock – Clare Road – 1 km north of Tarcowie
- Crystal Brook Gulnare – towards intersection with Main North Road.

More than half a billion dollars over four years is being spent on critical road maintenance and safety upgrades. More than \$341 million to be spent in the regional areas.

All too often country roads are accountable for casualties. With safety upgrades such as 'shoulder sealing', the risk of 'run-off' road crashes is reduced. Safety barriers are protection from roadside hazards, which help minimise the severity of accidents.

These roadworks are scheduled to be completed by the end of March 2017.
