Road and Rail Network Upgrades in Frome

"These road improvements are commitments the State Government made as part of Geoff's agreement with the Premier and will be crucial to improving safety on an our rural roads.

- ADDITIONAL ROAD FUNDING FOR REGIONAL ROAD IMPROVEMENTS
 Across the State over half a billion dollars is being spent on road safety and maintenance over four years and almost two-thirds of this will go to regional areas.
- ALFORD to PORT BROUGHTON
 Shoulder Sealing to 24kms of the Spencer Highway between Alford and Port Broughton.
- PORT BROUGHTON ROAD JUNCTION / SPENCER HIGHWAY
 Widening of the Spencer Highway at the junction with Port Broughton Road to allow vehicles travelling north to safely pass stationery vehicles to turn right.
- BALAKLAVA ROAD between PORT WAKEFILED & AUBURN
 Shoulder sealing to approximately 10kms on the Balaklava Road between Port Wakefield and Auburn.

These road works are planned to begin in late May 2017, and anticipated to be completed by the end of July, weather permitting.

Too many people die on country roads every year and while all road users are responsible for their own safety, projects such as these are also vital." Mr Brock said.

SNOWTOWN / BUTE INTERSECTION

Over the past few years Geoff has been continually lobbying the Government for essential improvement to the 'Intersection of the Bute – Snowtown Road' for a slow vehicle turnout on Augusta Highway.

"I am extremely pleased to see funds forthcoming to commence construction on these much needed road works, which will make a significant difference to our farmers who frequently utilise this intersection during harvest time with heavy vehicles" said Geoff.
