State-of-the-art safety warning system to be trialled at rural intersections.

This is an Australian First State of the Art Technology and is to warn vehicles to slow down or be alert of intersection ahead.

This technology triggers safety measures when vehicles are detected approaching intersections will be installed at four key rural locations. This technology has been found to slow vehicles as much as 20 kilometres per hour.

The Frome Electorate intersection of the Horrocks Highway and Stradbroke Road in Stanley Flat in one to be trialled.

This Rural Intersection Active Warning System is able to reduce the speed limit when it detects vehicles approaching an intersection. It lowers the speed limit on the major rural road by changing the electronic speed limit sign on the major road.

The Rural Intersection Active Warning Signs have been proven to reduce fatal and serious crashes by slowing motorists and making them aware of an approaching intersection.

I commend the government for the trial installation of this system. This investment will greatly improve the safety for all those travelling on rural roads.
