

COVID-19 Testing Clinics

All Yorke and Northern Local Health Network (YNLHN) services are to follow the COVID 19 Testing Clinic Protocols.

The below instructions for COVID 19 testing meet the approved criteria according to the COVID-19 response. When a person feels unwell and in need of emergency assistance, they are asked to contact or attend their nearest Emergency Department.
